3. What is a guarantee?
 - a. Dictionary defn.—“An assurance for the fulfillment of a condition.
 - b. An agreement by which one person undertakes to secure another in the possession or enjoyment of something.
 - c. An assurance of the quality of or the length of use to be expected from a product offered for sale often with a promise of reimbursement.
4. Man’s promises are not always reliable.
5. God’s promises or guarantees are always reliable.
